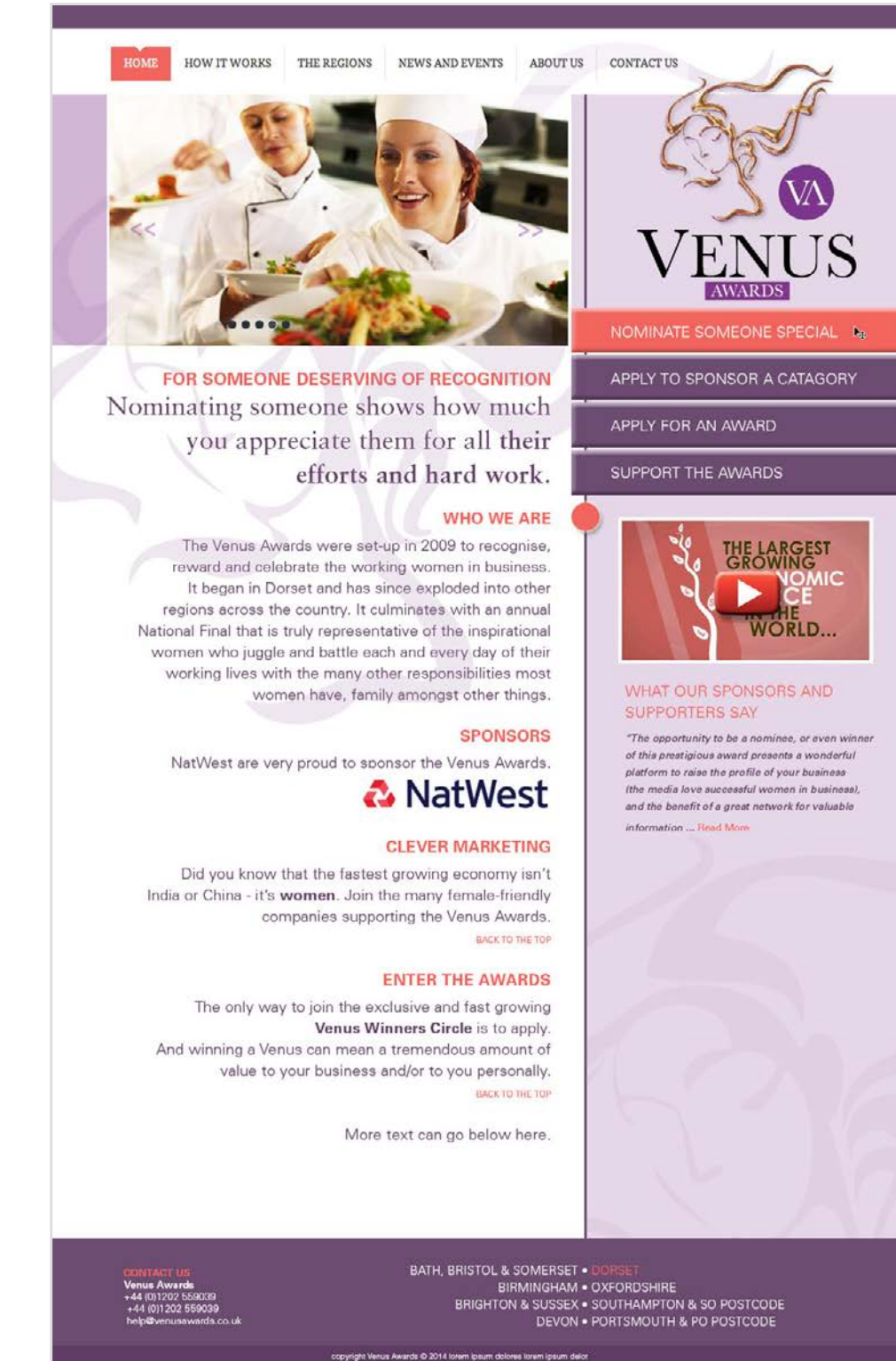
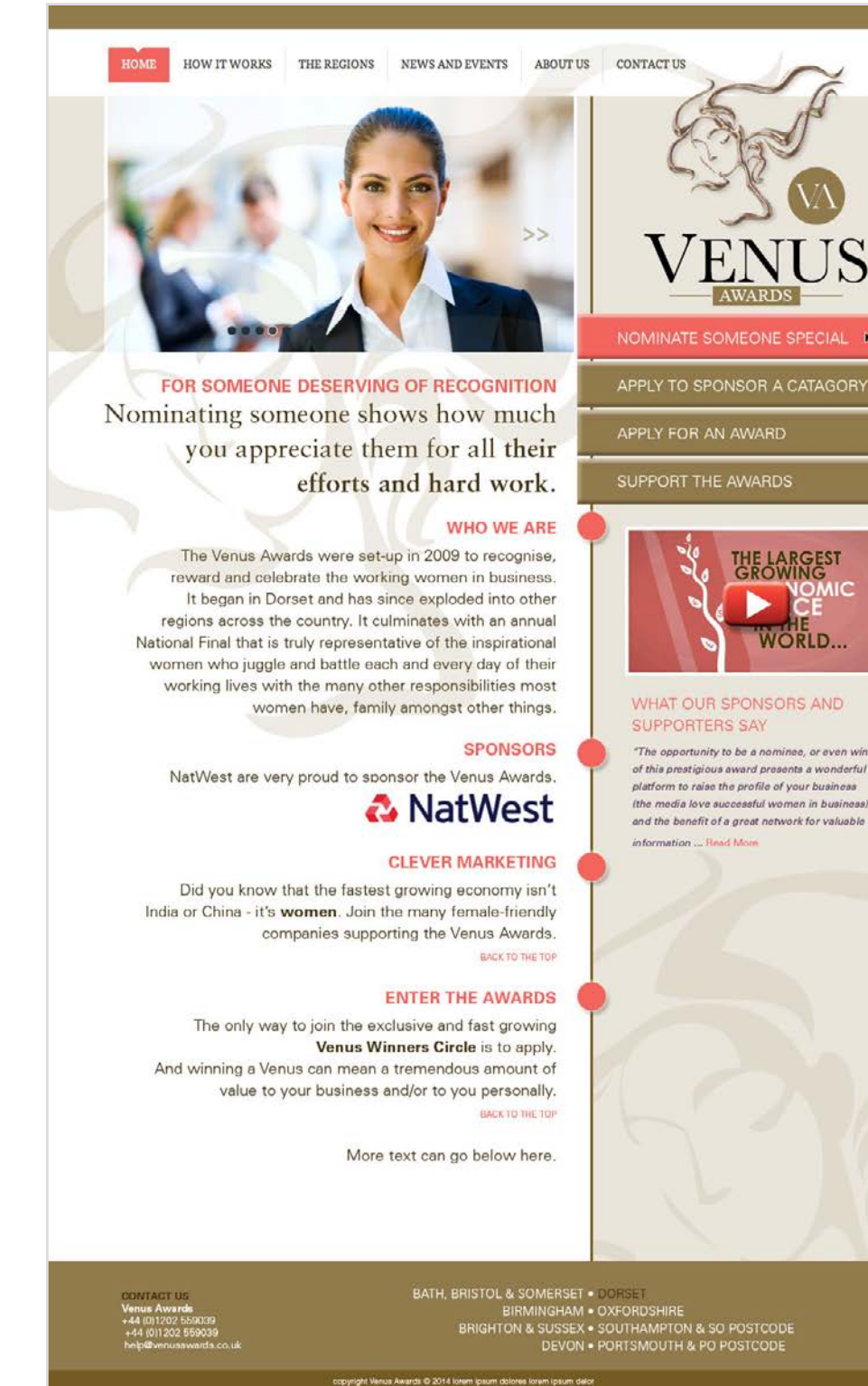

The Village School at the Heart of a Thriving City

There is an old saying that claims "It takes a village to raise a child", and we at Swaythling Primary School believe that there is a lot of truth in that. Equally, we recognise that time does not stand still, and have embraced the best of what modern life has to offer. We are well-equipped with IT equipment, and have a range of home-learning opportunities that mean the children can extend their learning beyond the normal school day.

Our breakfast and after school club mean that we offer wrap around care at the school from 7.30 in the morning to 5.45 in the evening, for those parents whose busy working lives require this flexibility.

You know your child better than anyone, for some a larger, busier school will be what you are looking for. For others children, a small, friendly, genuine community school will be the perfect environment in which to thrive educationally and personally. We customise every boat by using a series of unique implants and mould configurations to produce boat shapes specific to each of Pasco's customers, whilst minimising tooling costs.

Case Study - Marine Work Boats

Work Boats are playing an increasingly important role with Navies across the world, particularly unmanned boats which offer greater flexibility in dangerous situations. Specialist manufacturer ASV approached Norco to build three boats for the French Navy. The boats comprise a hull and deck and are made up of a monolithic structure on the hull bottom, with the same materials but in much fewer layers being used on the top sides of the hull and deck.

The key challenge on the project was to keep the weight down to the set ratios. The project was extremely weight critical for the end user and some of the tolerances were tight due to the amount and size of the equipment that was to be added to the boat.

MUSA

Banana

Bananas are a fruit of tropical Asia, celebrated above all in Indian and South East Asian art as a lush backdrop to dancing gods, evoking fertility. In Islamic tradition, the forbidden fruit in the Garden of Eden was a banana, and European nomenclature acknowledged this heritage by adopting the Arabic name *Musa* for the genus and adding two specific names, *Musa paradisica* or *M.sapientum* (wisdom). The link with brainpower and knowledge has now been endorsed by research into the beneficial chemicals in bananas, including potassium and dopamine. In China and Japan bananas arrived from the subtropical south and were again linked with scholarship. The sound of raindrops on banana leaves became an allusion to the philosopher poet in his hideaway, musing and writing. In Chinese gardens apt quotations carved on rocks recalled this association. The seventeenth-century Japanese poet Basho, famous for his haiku, took his *rom de plume* from the Japanese word for banana - planting one beside his hermit's hut and writing: 'Wind tossed banana leaves / An autumn night / Rain dripping in a basin.' More cheerfully, one of his followers responded: 'A tree frog / Clinging to a banana leaf / And raindrops pattering.'

Durian

Durian (*Durio zibenthinus*) is a fruit the size of a football from a large tree native to the forests of Borneo, Malaysia and Indonesia, which is now extensively cultivated in South East Asia. Inside the spiky green shell the seeds of durian are surrounded by a pulpy aril (fleshy envelope) which, according to one Victorian explorer, tastes like 'caramel and cream with a hint of strawberries'. The smell, however, is atrocious, described by the same explorer as 'onions, drains and coal gas'. But nature has its reasons: in the forests the smell of the ripening fruit would attract elephants, tigers, monkeys and many other creatures to join the feast. Durian was first described to Europeans by G. E. Rump in his *Herbarium Ambonense* (1741) and later its magnificent appearance (mercifully removed from its smell) made it a popular image of exotic fruit. Collections of natural history drawings expressed the growing fascination with botanical discovery, exemplified by Lord Wellesley, Stamford Raffles and Thomas Hardwicke, who all employed local artists. Raffles first recorded employing a Chinese artist from Macao in 1810, and subsequently the atelier he established at Bencoolen in Sumatra produced over 2,000 drawings - although most were lost at sea.

EXAMPLES AT HOME

You might use:

- A speech-activated device to order groceries, play music or perform an internet search.
- A toothbrush that displays how much time you should spend brushing.

- Computers you might come across:
- When you check out your groceries at the store, a computer tallies up the costs, checks store inventory and takes payment from you.
- Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) will check your bank balance and dispense money for you.
- Computers use facial recognition at passport controls to make travelling safer and more efficient.
- Crossing lights and traffic signals rely on a system of detectors and relays to respond to traffic changes and allow pedestrians to cross the road safely.
- Using a card with a chip in it for public transport.
- Security systems that monitor areas with cameras and motion sensors.
- Using an e-reader (electronic book) while relaxing on a bench in the park.

And so on. It's more and more likely that anything in your house might have computers and networking capabilities in them to help them talk, do or other things that you wouldn't normally expect them to do. How about a sensor fibre that replaces replacement fibres automatically when it runs out? Or a light bulb that can change colour when given instructions from your smartphone? These are examples of a new trend called the **Internet of Things** (IoT), where single purpose, everyday objects (such as a kettle or a doorbell) are made 'smarter' by putting a computer chip and network connectivity inside.

No matter their purpose, all these examples rely on computers and coders to order to operate.

Another term for computers being everywhere is **ubiquitous computing**.

What is Coding?

What do you think of when you hear the word code? Perhaps a secret code, where words and letters are changed around to prevent messages from falling into the wrong hands, or used as a fun way to communicate with your friends without anyone else finding out what you're talking about? Well, you're not wrong! **Encoding** is the process of taking information and converting it into different form, where **decoding** is the opposite - taking a coded message and turning it into a language that we can more easily understand.

Coding for computers is a lot like that too, where we convert our thoughts and processes into actions that we would like computers to do for us. We use programming languages to help us do that. Programming languages help bridge the gap between coders and computers by using words that we are more accustomed to understanding, and translating them into the language of numbers that only computers can understand. Sorry, we'll leave more about binary later on.

The most important thing to remember is that no matter how powerful computers are, the real power lies in the grey matter between your ears - your brain! Computer coders are the ones who help make computers do what they do, so let's get started and learn some more!

Computers Are Everywhere

If you take a look around, you will find that computers are just about everywhere these days. We can see them in our homes, at work, at school and also when we are out and about! The most common place that we might find a computer, however, would probably be in our pockets in the form of a smartphone. In fact our pocket computers are more powerful than the computers that originally put astronauts on the moon nearly fifty years ago! Not to mention that they are much smaller, too. Computers used to take up entire rooms and were only able to do specific functions. Now they can be worn on our wrists and perform a multitude of tasks. Smartphones today can actually carry out tasks that we needed specific, separate equipment to do only 25 years ago - imagine carrying around a phone, digital camera, video camera, calculator and more in your pocket!

Because computers are so powerful, we can them every day to help solve problems - and also entertain us. We might be so used to having computers everywhere that we probably don't even give it a second thought. Let's take a moment to consider the kind of computers we interact with on a regular basis.

How Computers Think

If our own brains have electrical impulses running through them to transmit information to other parts of the brain and body, how does a computer think? Again, it's a strange question.

BINARY

Binary is a way of counting, using only two numbers - a 0 and a 1. We control computers by telling small parts inside them (called **transistors**) to either be on or off so that electricity can go in the right directions and run a program. The 0 and 1 tell the transistors to either be on or off. Each 0 or 1 represents a bit (the smallest unit of computer storage).

All the inputs and outputs on a computer is represented by bits and lots of these binary numbers - whether it's your favourite video game, or a funny cat video on the internet. It's all made up of 0s and 1s being translated into code that your computer can understand. This kind of code is called **machine code**.

Did you know that the binary number system was developed by Gottfried Leibniz in 1679, over 300 years ago? In fact, evidence of binary systems has been found even further back than that.

A Brief Explanation on How Binary Works

One of the best ways to understand how binary works is to show you how to convert regular (decimal) numbers into 0s. With decimal numbers, we assign place values into columns, starting with the ones column, then the tens column, hundred column and so on. Each column goes up by the power of ten (10 is also known as base 10, or a **decimal** system).

100	10	1
3	4	2

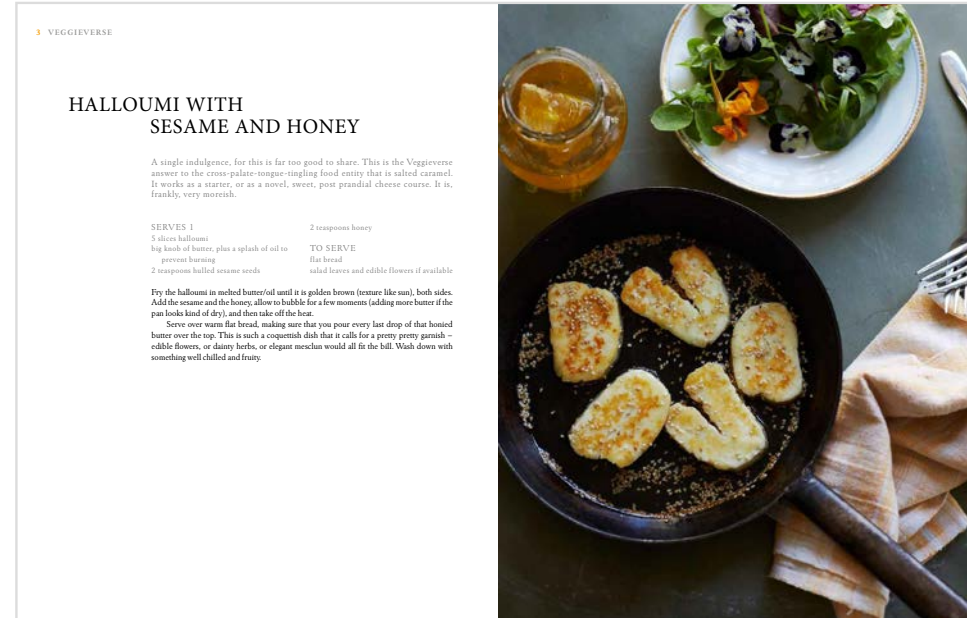
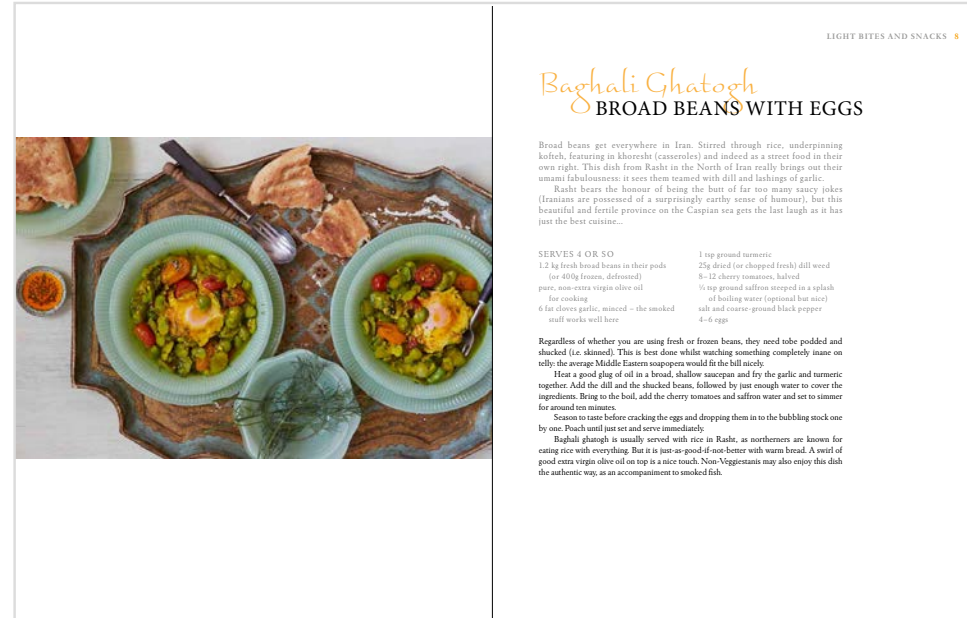
In the above table, we have a 3 in the ones column, a 4 in the tens column and a 3 in the hundred column. Three hundreds, four tens and two ones, which is 300 + 40 + 2 = 342. Binary columns increase by the power of two in each column, like so:

32	16	8	4	2	1
1	0	1	0	1	0

In the binary table above, there is a value of 1 in the 32, 8, and 2 columns, which we add up as 32 + 8 + 2 = 42. We would write that number as 101010. All these 0s and 1s are the language that computers understand: on or off, yes or no, true or false.

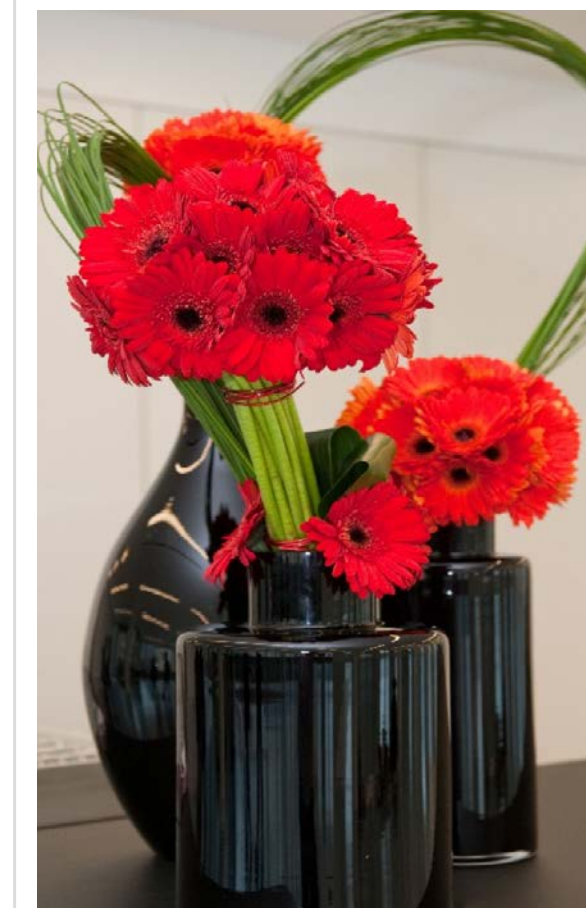
